WELCOME TO OBERSTAUFEN IN THE REGION OF ALLGÄU


Oberstaufen with its main districts of Steibis /Aach and Thalkirchdorf is located in the southernmost region of Germany in the border triangle of Germany, Austria and Switzerland. Centrally located between Neuschwanstein Castle (UNESCO World Heritage), the city of Kempten, which was founded 2000 years ago by the Romans, Lake Constance and Oberstdorf, famous for the Four Hills Tournament and the Nagelfluhkette, a mountain range on the northern edge of the Allgäu Alps, which extends to the south of the municipality of Oberstaufen.





OBERSTAUFEN | STEIBIS/AACH – AT A GLANCE

The Steibis/Aach district lies at 860 m and 647 m respectively. Steibis is the gateway to the largest area of connected alpine dairies in Germany. UP TO THE SUMMITS WITH THE MOUNTAIN TRANSPORT SYSTEMS ALL YEAR ROUND



Oberstaufen has no fewer than three mountain transport systems to take you up high. The cable cars take you up to the peaks of the Nagelfluhkette Nature Park in summer and winter. The journey itself is a pleasure: a unique panorama of the Allgäu Alps and Lake Constance all year round.



HOCHGRATBAHN

The nostalgic yellow 4-seater gondolas take you up to the mountain station at 1,708 metres above sea level. From there, it's a 25-minute hike to the 1,834 metre summit of the Hochgrat, the highest elevation in the Nagelfluhkette Nature Park. The effort is worth it: breathtaking views of the Allgäu and Bavarian Alps as well as Austrian and Swiss Alpine peaks and Lake Constance.

Winter – the almost six-kilometre-long natural sledging run promises plenty of fun and, in contrast, snowshoe hikers can enjoy the winter landscape at a leisurely pace. The exclusively unprepared ski routes are only recommended for advanced skiers, freeriders, deep-snow skiers and ski tourers.



IMBERGBAHN

The Imberg at 1,325 metres is located directly in the hiking area, which promises variety with two themed trails: the alpine adventure trail provides interesting facts about the Allgäu mountains and alpine farming, the MounTeens* detective trail (from 6 years) offers activities & fun for the whole family and the climbing garden is an active way to climb from tree to tree. Alpine huts serving regional dishes invite you to stop for a bite to eat.

Winter – whether big or small, beginner or pro, the Steibis ski arena promises fun and variety for everyone: skiers, snowboarders, snowshoe and ski tourers, winter hikers and sledging. In addition, the "little ones" are motivated to practise their first turns in the snow in the Ski-Kinderland.



HÜNDLEBAHN

Extensive hiking trails for beginners, children and advanced hikers start from the mountain station. The short hike up to the Hündlekopf at 1,112 metres rewards you with a panoramic view from the Alpsee lake all the way to Switzerland. On the first MounTeens* detective hiking trail (from 6 years), the tour with children is fun packed, with riddles to solve and activities to try out. Local alpine huts offer hearty snacks and homemade cakes. There is plenty of fun for children at the ground station: e.g. summer toboggan run, bungee trampoline, minigolf and small animal enclosure.



Winter – the small-scale yet beautiful Hündle-Thalkirchdorf ski area offers a variety of wide ski runs that are ideal for beginners as well as sporty skiers and snowboarders. In addition, the little ones benefit from the offer in the Ski-Kinderland.

MOUNTAIN TRANSPORT HIGHLIGHTS

Summer – special rides at sunrise and sunset, sometimes with an ecumenical church service accompanied by music, is something you shouldn't miss.

WINTER IN THE MOUNTAINS HOLIDAYS IN THE SNOW



The special charm of the snow-covered winter landscape not only attracts nature and winter sports enthusiasts to the outdoors.

The **three mountain cable car lifts** are a must in winter: with and without snow, there is something for every winter fan and sports enthusiast. The Imbergbahn with the Steibis ski arena and the Hündle-Thalkirchdorf ski association offer the best prepared ski runs for beginners, children and professionals. Experience the first turns in the snow or enjoy carving down wide slopes and race tracks for the more ambitious.

The **Sinswang ski lifts** are the perfect family and beginners ski area. The **on-site ski school** with children's area and magic carpet will quickly help you master your first fast-paced runs on the gently sloping terrain. The highlight for young and old alike is the unique 6-seater rocket lift, which masters the ascent at breakneck speed – an absolute joy! All ski schools use state-of-the-art methods to teach technique and skiing fun for all levels of ability.

Cross-country skiing – skating and classic – is possible on a total of eight trails of varying difficulty levels and distances. The cross-country ski schools teach all techniques and for varying abilities.

The **Kapfwald circuit** is the first premium winter hiking trail in the Allgäu region and has been recognised for its varied route. A total of around 90 kilometres of cleared or groomed winter hiking trails lead through the municipality.

And winter offers even more: horse-drawn sleigh rides through the snow-covered winter landscape, ice-rink disco, ice skating, curling on the ice rink in OberstaufenPARK and sledging runs of varying difficulty levels, parallel to the ski areas.


PREMIUM HIKING RESORT AND NATURE PARK



The Nagelfluhkette Nature Park is the first and so far, the only cross-border nature park between the German region of Allgäu/Bavaria and the Austrian Bregenzerwald in the state of Vorarlberg. Enjoy the multifaceted natural landscape along picturesque streams, valleys and mountain ranges between 647 and 1,834 metres. Four hiking trails have been recognised as Premium Hiking Trails by the German Hiking Institute. The outstanding quality of service and the hiking infrastructure around the four premium hiking trails "Luftiger Grat" on the Hochgrat, "Alpenfreiheit" and "Grenzenloser Weitblick" on the Imberg and "Wildes Wasser" on the Hündle promise a special hiking experience. A total of 300 kilometres of hiking trails offer wonderful nature experiences.




